 - a maximum 2 page resume indicating previous exhibitions and training or a short narrative biography telling us more about yourself and your artistic endeavors
- If an application is selected, works to be exhibited must be finished; that is, *ready to hang*. All works to be exhibited must be accompanied by clear indication of artist's name, medium of work, year of creation, and price (if applicable) on the rear of the piece.
- Your signature on this application acknowledges your understanding of these rules.
